The symposium, an annual event organised by first-year PhD students at the European Molecular Biology Laboratory in Germany, brings together fellow students from around the world for a three-day series of talks by leading experts. It's an opportunity to make connections with international scientists and get new insight into your own research direction.

This year's theme is 'Game Changers: Taking Life Sciences to the Next Level'. The program includes networking opportunities, poster sessions and workshops with experts.

Ten PhD students will receive financial support of \$2,000 to attend the EMBL PhD Symposium in Heidelberg, Germany.

The grants are open to students in almost any field - biology, chemistry, physics, mathematics, informatics, engineering and molecular medicine - who are currently enrolled in a PhD program at any Australian university, and have not yet submitted a thesis.
